

DD MailChimp and Domain Setup

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STEP 1: Find a .com domain

- Google "Domain Search"
- If it's available (not a premium domain), let us know and we can buy it.
- Provide me with your login credentials to your hosting account/FTP
 - Username
 - Password

STEP 2: Edit your Site Info

- Once I set up your site on your domain, I will let you know so you can edit the info.
- Site will be edited on: <https://inbrowserediting.adobe.com/login/>
 - I will give you login credentials.
 - Editing is in-browser editing, so it's simple.

STEP 3: Open MailChimp.com Account

- If you're buying the domain and don't yet have an email address. We can create one for you.
- Use your new email address (**tied to your personal domain**) to open a [MailChimp.com](https://mailchimp.com) Account

STEP 4: Upload a list of contacts

- MailChimp sends based on Lists, not individuals
 - You can upload lists of names and email addresses
 - You can add or subtract from lists
- These lists should be people from whom you have consent to send an email

STEP 5: Create or Import email templates

- Import from Fathom Email Depository (<https://www.fathomwiki.com/knowledgebase/email-depository/>)
 - You must edit your personal info
- Create one (try duplicating an existing email template)
- Don't include your fathom email address anywhere. If you want to send them somewhere, send them to your personal website.
- Do me a favor, if you create an email that you think would be helpful, please share it with me and I can add it to the depository for other to use.

STEP 6: Test your email

- Send it to your inbox and make sure everything looks good before blasting the whole list.

STEP 7: Send It to your List

- Note, you can't send these emails to one person at a time.** The MailChimp platform is designed to send to a list of people.
- HOWEVER!** you can segment the list by "Date Added."
 - This means if you have an Introduction email that you want to send out to all **NEW** contacts every week, you can **segment the list** by contacts added within the last so many days OR you can segment the list by those added **AFTER** the last campaign you sent.
 - So, in other words, you can send an email to the new people to get them in the drip system.
